ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Oral presentations and posters will be showcased in person at the FD/MAS Madrid Meeting on Saturday, October 25th. This exhibition will highlight the work of researchers and advocates to a diverse audience of physicians, researchers, patients, families, and funders.

ABSTRACT CONTENT

- **Language:** English
- **Abstract Title Length:** Maximum of 25 words
- **Abstract Body Length:** Maximum of 300 words, including numbers and symbols.
- **Format:** Word or PDF document
- **Tables and Figures:**
 - One table and one figure (image) are permitted per abstract.
 - Tables: Each word or number in the table counts towards the total word count.
 - Figures: Images do **not** count towards the total word count. Figures can be attached separately in a PDF, JPEG, or PNG.

DATA REQUIREMENT

Abstracts will be considered for oral presentation only if they include quantitative data (e.g., numbers, graphs, or images), except for the categories of clinical cases and innovative methods.

SUGGESTED ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

- Background/Introduction
- Purpose
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion(s)

We encourage the submission of original scientific work. If the research (or substantially similar material) has already been presented as an oral presentation at another international meeting or congress within Europe prior to submission to the IC FD/MAS Meeting 2025, it will only be considered for poster presentation.

Deadline for abstract submission is on **August 31st, 2025.**

VIDEOS

Authors of accepted posters are encouraged to create a 3-minute video in lay language to explain their poster to a general audience. These videos will be linked to QR codes displayed alongside the posters to facilitate deeper engagement.

ABSTRACT REVIEW & NOTIFICATIONS

A panel of qualified reviewers will evaluate all abstracts based on scientific and clinical merit. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to determine the mode of presentation (oral or poster) in line with the program's objectives.

Authors will be notified of acceptance and presentation details by email during the week of September 15th, 2025. Instructions for preparing oral and poster presentations will be included in these notifications.

PRESENTATION & REGISTRATION

To be included in the final scientific program, presenting authors

must register for the congress and complete payment upon notification of abstract acceptance.

Please note that all expenses related to the preparation, submission, and presentation of an abstract are the responsibility of the presenter(s)/author(s).

INSCRIPTION GRANTS

The FD/MAS Scientific Advisory Board will award registration grants to selected applicants. The deadline to submit abstracts as part of the application for these grants is July 15th. Selected applicants will be notified before August 1st, 2025. **Please note that the availability of these grants depends on funding from potential sponsors and is therefore not guaranteed at this time.**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR INSCRIPTION GRANTS

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- Be enrolled as a full-time student at a university or college (in Spain or abroad) pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in the sciences, medicine, or a related field.
- Hold a junior faculty position at a research institution.
- Be an early-career researcher.

Each grant is limited to one person, either as an individual researcher or the designated representative of a research project team.

IMPORTANT DATES

- **July 15, 2025:** Deadline for abstract submission for inscription grants applica
- **August 31, 2025:** Deadline for abstract submissions
- **September 15, 2025:** Notification of poster acceptance.
- **October 24, 2025:** Accepted posters must be delivered and mounted by 4:30 p.m.
